TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

KEY IDEAS: Do I recognize that God's plans for me are certain and cannot be turned back? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one that He has chosen and has determined to make blameless? Does my life demonstrate that God's plan for my life is good? Does my life demonstrate that God's plan for my life is pleasing? Does my life demonstrate that God's plan for my life is perfect?

1 **God is Sovereign over His plan** — *Isaiah 14:24 The LORD of hosts hath sworn, saying, Surely as I have thought, so shall it come to pass; and as I have purposed, so shall it stand....27 For the LORD of hosts hath purposed, and who shall disannul it? and his hand is stretched out, and who shall turn it back?*

What does it make me realize to know that God's plan cannot be blocked?

What examples of God's plan being fulfilled in my life can I praise Him for?

2 **I am chosen by God** — *Ephesians 1:4 According as he hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love....*

How does the fact that God has chosen me make me feel?

Why does the enemy want me to think that my connection to God is indefinite?

3 **I am to demonstrate God's will is good, pleasing and complete** — *Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what [is] that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.*

How does my life demonstrate that God's will is good, pleasing and complete?

In what new ways could my life show God's will is good, pleasing or complete?

Spirit of Glory, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
