TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

KEY IDEAS: Do I recognize that I am accountable to the Lord? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one that has been given eternal life and made an heir? Can I praise God even when bad things are happening in my life knowing He has my best interest at heart? Do I praise God in good times as well as in the bad?

1 **God is the Judge and Heir of the whole earth** — *Psalm 82:8 Arise, O God, judge the earth: for thou shalt inherit all nations.*

What insight does this verse give me about my relationship to God?

Based upon God's promises, what future blessings can I praise Him for?

2 **I am an heir according to the hope of eternal life** — *Titus 3:6 Which he shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour; 7 That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.*

How does an heir with a large inheritance behave? How then should I behave?

What does the devil get me to think to make me cynical about my future?

3 **I am to seek to be hopeful by praising the Lord** — *Psalm 43:5 Why art thou cast down, O my soul? and why art thou disquieted within me? hope in God: for I shall yet praise him, who is the health of my countenance, and my God.*

When I am responsible for another person, how do I act to benefit him/her?

Why should I be hopeful since God is responsible for my life and salvation?

Spirit of Truth, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
