TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

KEY IDEAS: Do I understand that my future inheritance is so great that it is silly to be preoccupied with here and now? Do I see myself as God sees me, do I see myself as an heir of God that will inherit the world? Am I living like an heir or am I living to exploit my situation now in order to get whatever I can for myself?

1 **God has promised that those who hope in Him will inherit the earth — Psalm 37:9** *For evildoers shall be cut off: but those that wait upon the LORD, they shall inherit the earth.*

What evidence exists that my life demonstrates hope and patience?

What illustrations of God dispensing justice can I praise Him for?

2 **I am an heir of the world — Romans 4:13** *For the promise, that he should be the heir of the world, [was] not to Abraham, or to his seed, through the law, but through the righteousness of faith.*

What evidence is there in my life that shows I am living for a future inheritance?

Why does the devil want me to always question God's justice and judgment?

3 **I am to act as an heir as is illustrated by the expectation of God's people in the past — Deuteronomy 16:19** *Thou shalt not wrest judgment; thou shalt not respect persons, neither take a gift: for a gift doth blind the eyes of the wise, and pervert the words of the righteous. 20 That which is altogether just shalt thou follow, that thou mayest live, and inherit the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee.*

How does my life demonstrate integrity and a passion for justice?

What steps could I take to demonstrate that I am a person with a destiny?

Holy Spirit, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
