TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

KEY IDEAS: Do I look for solutions to my problems and look to fulfill my needs with things that are temporary? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one with an eternal destiny and whom He desires to help? If you couldn't borrow money how would it change your approach to solving your problems?

1 **God is eternal and His truth is everlasting** — *Psalm 100:5 For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth endureth to all generations.*

How does my life reflect the fact that God and His promises are eternal?

What examples of God's eternal promises can I praise Him for?

2 **I am promised an eternal inheritance** — *Hebrews 9:15 And for this cause he is the mediator of the new testament, that by means of death, for the redemption of the transgressions [that were] under the first testament, they which are called might receive the promise of eternal inheritance.*

Why should I be emboldened by the fact that nothing can harm or stop Jesus?

Why does Satan want me to believe that he has unlimited power over me?

3 **I am to walk in faith, trusting in the Lord rather than things** — *Psalm 20:7 Some trust in chariots, and some in horses: but we will remember the name of the LORD our God.*

When you are in trouble, what do you turn to first? Do you pray first?

List some examples where you sought God's help to solve your problems?
