TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

KEY IDEAS: Do I recognize that God is set apart from evil, and yet, has made Himself approachable by sinful men? Do I see myself as God sees me that I am set apart from evil and consecrated unto Him for service?

1 **By nature, God is holy** — *Revelation 15:4 Who shall not fear thee, O Lord, and glorify thy name? for thou only art holy: for all nations shall come and worship before thee; for thy judgments are made manifest.*

What do I learn about God if He is holy, and yet, all nations will come to Him?

How should I praise God for consecrating me and setting me apart from evil?

2 **I am holy (set apart from evil and consecrated unto the Lord for His purpose)** — *1 Corinthians 1:2 Unto the church of God which is at Corinth, to them that are sanctified in Christ Jesus, called [to be] saints, with all that in every place call upon the name of Jesus Christ our Lord, both theirs and ours....*

What does it imply if they were called ""saints"" and still had struggles with sin?

Why does the devil want me to think that I am never good enough?

3 **I am to consecrate (set myself apart for God's purpose) myself by cultivating a respect and reverence for God** — *Isaiah 8:13 Sanctify the LORD of hosts himself; and let him be your fear, and let him be your dread.*

How does my life exhibit a reverence for God?

What must be purged from my life in order to increase my reverence for God?

Spirit of Glory, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
