TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

KEY IDEAS: Do I think of God as unfair and question His actions, or do I recognize that He is always fair? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one that is accountable to Him? Am I currently engaged any activities that are self-destructive?

1 **God's dealings with men are always right and just [equal] — Ezekiel 18:29** *Yet saith the house of Israel, The way of the Lord is not equal. O house of Israel, are not my ways equal? are not your ways unequal?*

What encouragement does it give me to know that God is fair and just?

What examples of God's judgment and fairness can I praise Him for?

2 **I am held accountable for my actions by God Who judges accurately — Psalm 7:8** *The LORD shall judge the people: judge me, O LORD, according to my righteousness, and according to mine integrity [that is] in me.*

How does the fact that I am accountable to God impact my actions?

Why does Satan want me to think of myself as hopelessly out of control?

3 **I am to pursue righteousness (do what is right), and I will spare myself injury — Proverbs 10:2** *Treasures of wickedness profit nothing: but righteousness delivereth from death.*

What self-destructive behaviors have I turned away from?

What self-destructive behaviors and tendencies do I need to turn away from?

Spirit of Wisdom, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
