## TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

**KEY IDEAS:** Do I recognize that I am promised that God will meet my needs if I will seek? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one that is destined to inherit all things? Am I looking for every opportunity to pray? Am I courageous in the prayer requests that I bring before the Lord?

**1** **God will supply all of my needs** — *Psalm 34:10 The young lions do lack, and suffer hunger: but they that seek the LORD shall not want any good thing.*

In what ways does my life demonstrate that I am seeking the Lord?

What examples of God's provision can I praise Him for?

**2** **Through Christ all things are mine** — *1 Corinthians 3:22 Whether Paul, or Apollos, or Cephas, or the world, or life, or death, or things present, or things to come; all are yours.*

When I read the phrase "all are yours

what does it make me realize?

**3** **I am to be courageous in prayer** — *John 16:23 And in that day ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give it you.*

Why does the devil only want me to focus on the things that are present?

What things keep me from going to the Lord in prayer with every opportunity?

What things am I too timid to pray for?, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
