TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

KEY IDEAS: Do I understand that the Lord would like to give me the proper desire that are in my heart? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one in whom the Lord delights? Do I understand that since the Lord delights in me that I can boldly bring things before Him in prayer?

1 **God has promised to give us the desires of our heart** — *Psalm 37:4 Delight thyself also in the LORD; and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart.*

How does my life demonstrate that I delight myself in the Lord?

When has God given me the desires of my heart?

2 **I am the object of God's delight** — *Psalm 16:3 But to the saints that are in the earth, and to the excellent, in whom is all my delight.*

How does it make me feel to know that the Lord delights in me?

Why does Satan want me to think that God is indifferent toward me?

3 **I am to be a person who asks confidently in prayer** — *Luke 11:10 For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.*

In prayer what things am I asking for with confidence?

What things do I need to be bringing before the Lord in prayer?

Holy Spirit, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
