TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

KEY IDEAS: Do I understand that God as the most powerful being in the universe worked to bring us into relationship with Himself? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one that has been saturated with (imbued with) the righteousness of Christ? Am I allowing Christ's character to saturate my life?

1 **God is our righteousness** — *Jeremiah 33:16* *In those days shall Judah be saved, and Jerusalem shall dwell safely: and this [is the name] wherewith she shall be called, The LORD our righteousness.*

Why is my connection to, and standing before, God incorruptible?

What examples of God's right ways am I stirred to praise Him for?

2 **I am in Christ Jesus** — *1 Corinthians 1:30* *But of him are ye in Christ Jesus, who of God is made unto us wisdom, and righteousness, and sanctification, and redemption:*

If I allow it, how could these traits from Christ's character impact my life?

In what ways can Christ's character become integrated into my life?

3 **I am to pursue the right kind of lifestyle** — *Proverbs 15:9* *The way of the wicked [is] an abomination unto the LORD: but he loveth him that followeth after righteousness.*

How does my life demonstrate that I am seeking to do what is right?

In what areas am I most vulnerable to deviate from the path of righteousness?

Holy Spirit, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
