## TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

**KEY IDEAS:** Do I understand that I must walk in purity? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one in whom He desires His love for others to dwell and through whom He desires His love to be demonstrated? How am I continuing in Christ's teaching and in fellowship with His followers? Does my prayer life demonstrate that I am following Christ?

**1** **God walked in the midst of His people** — *Deuteronomy 23:14 For the LORD thy God walketh in the midst of thy camp, to deliver thee, and to give up thine enemies before thee; therefore shall thy camp be holy: that he see no unclean thing in thee, and turn away from thee.*

What do I learn about God since He cannot be near any uncleanness (sin)?

What examples of God's patience with my failures can I praise Him for?

**2** **I am a dwelling for Christ and His love** — *John 17:26 And I have declared unto them thy name, and will declare [it]: that the love wherewith thou hast loved me may be in them, and I in them.*

In what ways does my life demonstrate God's love and that He lives in me?

How does Satan benefit if I behave with resentment and bitterness?

**3** **I am to abide in God's love** — *1 John 4:16 And we have known and believed the love that God hath to us. God is love; and he that dwelleth in love dwelleth in God, and God in him.*

Am I walking in: Christ's teaching, the Holy Spirit, fellowship and prayer?

How can I improve in my walk in the three areas mentioned above?

Spirit of Glory, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
