TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

KEY IDEAS: Do I realize that the Lord has always provided for His children day by day? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one that He will provide sufficiently for each day? Do I understand that one of the ways the Lord provides for me is through my own diligence and work?

1 **God provided for Israel day by day** — *Deuteronomy 2:7 For the LORD thy God hath blessed thee in all the works of thy hand: he knoweth thy walking through this great wilderness: these forty years the LORD thy God hath been with thee; thou hast lacked nothing.*

In what ways does the Lord provide for His children in our day?

What examples of God's provision in my life that I can praise Him for?

2 **I am guaranteed God's adequate supply** — *Philippians 4:19 But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.*

When is it evident that I'm asking for more than the Lord's adequate supply?

Why does the devil want me to be dissatisfied with enough to meet my needs?

3 **I am to be industrious and work** — *1 Thessalonians 4:12 And that ye study to be quiet, and to do your own business, and to work with your own hands, as we commanded you; 12 That ye may walk honestly toward them that are without, and that ye may have lack of nothing.*

If I'm unwilling to work, why shouldn't I expect the Lord to supply my needs ?

Based upon these verses, what could happen if I deal dishonestly with the lost?

Spirit of Truth, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
