	What relief does it give to know that God's throne is prepared for judgment?
	What examples of God's deliverance from my enemies can I praise Him for?
2	I am hidden in the Lord from my sins and protected from my enemies — Psalm 91:1 He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. 2 I will say of the LORD, [He is] my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust.
	What help does it give to know that nothing can happen beyond His control?
	Why does Satan want me to think that I face threats outside of His control?
3	I need to be vigilant to keep the devil from gaining ground where the Lord has defeated him — 1 Peter 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about, seeking whom he may devour
	Over what sins have I been able to gain control only to experience a setback?
	In what areas of my life do I continue to give the enemy a foothold?
	Spirit of Truth, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
