## TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

**KEY IDEAS:** Do I recognize that God is the greatest gift and blessing that a person can have? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one to whom He intends to grant a blessing that the world cannot contain? Does my life demonstrate both a gentle spirit and resilient character?

**1** **God is sufficient as an inheritance** — *Ezekiel 44:28 And it shall be unto them for an inheritance: I am their inheritance: and ye shall give them no possession in Israel: I am their possession.*

What benefits cannot be derived from land or things but God can give me?

What examples of God's superiority to things can I praise Him for?

**2** **I am promised God as my inheritance** — *Psalms 16:5 The LORD [is] the portion of mine inheritance and of my cup: thou maintainest my lot.*

In what ways is God a superior inheritance to a piece of land?

Why does the devil want me to measure blessing in terms of material things?

**3** **I am to seek to demonstrate a mild disposition and gentle spirit in keeping with my destiny** — *Matthew 5:5 Blessed [are] the meek: for they shall inherit the earth.*

How does my life show that I have a hope that looks beyond here and now?

In what way does my life demonstrate a meek spirit and a strong character?

Spirit of Glory, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
