## TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

**KEY IDEAS:** Do I understand that it is impossible for God to lie or commit any evil act? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one that He has destined to be without any sinful blemish? Am I seeking to live in light of my future? Or, am I living in the shadow of my past?

**1** **God is incapable of acting wickedly** — *Job 34:10 Therefore hearken unto me, ye men of understanding: far be it from God, that he should do wickedness; and from the Almighty, that he should commit iniquity.*

What evil things do men wrongfully accuse God of doing?

For what things do I need to praise God because I now know He was right?

**2** **I am destined to be without blemish** — *Ephesians 5:27 That he might present it to himself a glorious church, not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but that it should be holy and without blemish.*

Why is it important for me to focus on my future rather than my past?

Why does the devil want me to dwell on my past failures?

**3** **I am to pursue being spotless and blameless (now)** — *2 Peter 3:14 Wherefore, beloved, seeing that ye look for such things, be diligent that ye may be found of him in peace, without spot, and blameless.*

How should I walk now since the Lord will make me spotless in the future?

Why would it be shameful and reckless to live a disobedient lifestyle now?

Spirit of Wisdom, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
