TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

KEY IDEAS: Do I recognize that God is zealous of what is good and right? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one that has been given the privilege of championing what is right and good? Am I taking steps to lay aside any activity that is an offense to the Lord? Am I incorporating behaviors into my life that are good and right?

1 **God's name is jealous (zealous) — Exodus 34:14** *For thou shalt worship no other god: for the LORD, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous God....*

Why is it comforting to think of God as zealous for what is right and good?

What examples of God's zeal for what is right and good can I praise Him for?

2 **I am redeemed and God's possession. It is His plan that I be zealous now — Titus 2:14** *Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people, zealous of good works.*

All Christians should be zealous for what good works?

Why does Satan want me to be indifferent toward what is right and good?

3 **I am to be jealous (I am to be zealous concerning God's will) — Revelation 3:19** *As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten: be zealous therefore, and repent.*

What behaviors in my life are considered offensive to God?

Which actions that are considered right and good need to be a part of my life?

Spirit of Wisdom, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
