TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

KEY IDEAS: Do I remind myself about the fact that God is unable to act wickedly or incapable of faulty judgment? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one that has been made right with Him by His work rather than mine? Do I understand that it is beneficial to remember where I've come from spiritually?

1 **God is right and just in all that He does** — *Deuteronomy 32:4 He is the Rock, his work is perfect: for all his ways are judgment: a God of truth and without iniquity, just and right is he.*

Why is it important for me to grasp that God is without iniquity?

What examples of God's purity and justice can I praise Him for?

2 **I am righteous before God because of my faith** — *Romans 4:5 But to him that worketh not, but believeth on him that justifieth the ungodly, his faith is counted for righteousness.*

What advantage is it to me that I am justified by faith rather than works?

Why does the devil want me to think that I am justified by my works?

3 **I am to let God's way (the pursuit of righteousness) rule my life** — *Isaiah 51:1 Hearken to me, ye that follow after righteousness, ye that seek the LORD: look unto the rock whence ye are hewn, and to the hole of the pit whence ye are digged.*

What happens when I ignore how God delivered me from sin?

What occurs when I consider how I've been changed by what God has done?

Spirit of Wisdom, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
