## TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

**KEY IDEAS:** Do I recognize that all who have a spiritual hunger can come to the Lord and be satisfied? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one who can always come to the Him in sincerity and truth and find Him approachable? Am I as accepting of others as the Lord is accepting of me?

**1** **God is generous in inviting all to come to Him** — *Isaiah 55:3 Incline your ear, and come unto me: hear, and your soul shall live; and I will make an everlasting covenant with you, even the sure mercies of David.*

What do I learn about God since all who are spiritually hungry are invited?

What examples of God's personal interest and friendship can I praise Him for?

**2** **I am drawn to the Lord by the Father and I will not be cast out** — *John 6:37 All that the Father giveth me shall come to me; and him that cometh to me I will in no wise cast out. 38 For I came down from heaven, not to do mine own will, but the will of him that sent me.*

How does it cause me to feel to know that the Lord will not reject me?

Why does the devil want me to think that the Lord will reject me or others?

**3** **I am to seek an accepting attitude toward others** — *Romans 14:1 Him that is weak in the faith receive ye, but not to doubtful disputations.... 13 Let us not therefore judge one another any more: but judge this rather, that no man put a stumblingblock or an occasion to fall in his brother's way.*

How do I react when other Christians embrace cultural practices that I reject?

What keeps me from following my own conscience without judging others?

Spirit of Wisdom, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
