TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

KEY IDEAS: Do I understand that men still possess God's image and likeness in themselves? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one that is destined to be conformed unto the image and likeness of His Son? Do I recognize that I am to demonstrate Christ's likeness today by being forgiving to others?

1 **God created man in His image and likeness** — *Genesis 1:27 So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.*

In what ways do I think that God's image and likeness is in me?

What examples of God's image and likeness can I praise Him for?

2 **I am destined to be conformed unto Christ's image** — *Romans 8:29 For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate [to be] conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.*

How do I expect my life to change as it is conformed unto Christ's image?

Why does Satan want me to think I'll never change and I'll never get it?

3 **I am now to be conformed to Christ and forgive others** — *Colossians 3:13 Forbearing one another, and forgiving one another, if any man have a quarrel against any: even as Christ forgave you, so also [do] ye.*

In what ways does my life demonstrate Christ's likeness to others?

In what ways does my life show the kind of forgiveness Jesus showed others?

Spirit of Wisdom, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
