TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

KEY IDEAS: Do I recognize that the Lord delivered me from my spiritual wilderness? Do I understand that He delivered me from the skeleton's in my family closet? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one that has been delivered from the power and consequences of my sin? Does my life demonstrate with increasing measure greater maturity and strength?

1 **God determined beforehand to call, judge righteous and glorify those who would believe** — *Jeremiah 30:18 Thus saith the LORD; Behold, I will bring again the captivity of Jacob's tents, and have mercy on his dwellingplaces; and the city shall be builded upon her own heap, and the palace shall remain after the manner thereof. 19 And out of them shall proceed thanksgiving and the voice of them that make merry: and I will multiply them, and they shall not be few; I will also glorify them, and they shall not be small.*

Out of what spiritual wilderness did God call me?

What examples of God's deliverance can I praise Him for?

2 **I am delivered through the Lord's power from the consequences of my sin** — *Psalms 118:14 The LORD [is] my strength and song, and is become my salvation.*

Why is it beneficial that God is the foundation to my salvation rather than me?

Why does Satan want me to think that I'm the foundation to my salvation?

3 **I am to allow the Lord to complete and strengthen me** — *1 Peter 5:10 But the God of all grace, who hath called us unto his eternal glory by Christ Jesus, after that ye have suffered a while, make you perfect, stablish, strengthen, settle [you].*

In what way's does my life demonstrate greater maturity and strength?

In what areas of my life do I need to exercise greater maturity and strength?
