TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

KEY IDEAS: Do I recognize that when I follow the path designed by God I am spared the consequences of foolish behavior? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one that is completely forgiven and free from condemnation? Does my life point the way a person can be spared reaping the harvest that comes from sin?

1 **God's presence is light (He is without evil and does what is right) — Psalm 89:15** *Blessed is the people that know the joyful sound: they shall walk, O LORD, in the light of thy countenance.*

In contrast to the world, to what actions does the Lord point me to follow?

By following His path, how has the Lord spared me the consequences of evil?

2 **I am a child of light and spared the consequences of evil and punishment — 1 Thessalonians 5:5** *Ye are all the children of light, and the children of the day: we are not of the night, nor of darkness.*

What evil things have I done for which God has forgiven me?

Why does the devil want me to think that God condemns me constantly?

3 **I am to walk in truth and righteousness to light the way for the lost — Isaiah 42:6** *I the LORD have called thee in righteousness, and will hold thine hand, and will keep thee, and give thee for a covenant of the people, for a light of the Gentiles....*

In what way does my life point the way for others to follow Christ?

What things could I begin to do that would point the way for others to follow?

Spirit of Glory, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
