TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

KEY IDEAS: Do I understand that I have a need to glorify the Lord through thanksgiving and praise? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one upon whom Christ's glory will be poured out? Do I recognize that I am to draw attention to God's authority and works by how I live?

1 **God's presence is evident from His glory** — *Exodus 40:34* Then a cloud covered the tent of the congregation, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle.

In what different ways does God glorify Himself?

For which of God's works would it be fitting that I praise Him?

2 **I am destined to receive glory** — *Romans 8:18* For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time [are] not worthy [to be compared] with the glory which shall be revealed in us.

When have I been mocked, slandered or threatened for being a Christian?

Why does the devil want me to overlook any suffering I've faced?

3 **I am to seek to draw attention (glorify) to the Lord** — *1 Peter 4:16* Yet if any man suffer as a Christian, let him not be ashamed; but let him glorify God on this behalf.

In what ways does my life draw attention to the Lord's character and works?

What evidence is there that I am ashamed of being identified as a Christian?

Spirit of Truth, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
