TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

KEY IDEAS: Do I recognize that a firsthand knowledge of God is more significant than a secondhand knowledge? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one that He wants to know as a friend and that He wants to know Him? Is my knowledge of God clinical or personal?

1 **God allows men to know Him** — *Proverbs 9:10 The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom: and the knowledge of the holy is understanding.*

How has my understanding and knowledge of the Lord grown and expanded?

In what ways has the Lord allowed me to know Him that I praise Him for?

2 **I am blessed with a first hand knowledge of God** — *Galatians 4:9 But now, after that ye have known God, or rather are known of God, how turn ye again to the weak and beggarly elements, whereunto ye desire again to be in bondage?*

What are the most important things that I've learned about God?

In what ways has my knowledge of God gone downhill?

3 **I am to be a person who seeks to increase his knowledge of the Lord** — *Ephesians 1:17 That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him.*

In what ways do I want my knowledge of the Lord to improve?

What's the difference between knowing God and knowing about God?

Spirit of Glory, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
