TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

KEY IDEAS: Do I recognize that I have already been judged to be in right standing with God? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one upon whom He has already poured out the gift of righteousness? Does my life demonstrate a commitment to personal purity? Is my commitment to personal purity eroding?

1 **God is right and pure in all His dealings with others — Psalm 145:17** *The LORD is righteous in all his ways, and holy in all his works.*

How does God treat His creatures versus how men treat each other?

For which of the Lord's dealings with mankind do I need to praise Him?

2 **I am the recipient of God's abundant gift of grace and righteousness — Romans 5:17** *For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.)*

How does my life demonstrate that I have been made right with God?

Why does the devil want me to think that I'm spiritually dirty and unclean?

3 **I am to pursue purity — 1 Timothy 5:22** *Lay hands suddenly on no man, neither be partaker of other men's sins: keep thyself pure.*

What transformations have taken place in my life since I first trusted Christ?

What things remain to be purged from my life in order to maintain a pure life?

Spirit of Wisdom, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
