## TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

**KEY IDEAS:** Do I understand that the Lord's love is broad and directed at all men?  
Do I see myself as God sees me, as one that has been called and chosen by God?  
Do I live in such a way that I demonstrate the breadth of Christ's love to others?

**1** **God determined beforehand to demonstrate salvation to the Gentiles** — *Acts 13:47 For so hath the Lord commanded us, saying, I have set thee to be a light of the Gentiles, that thou shouldest be for salvation unto the ends of the earth. 48 And when the Gentiles heard this, they were glad, and glorified the word of the Lord: and as many as were ordained to eternal life believed.*

What do I learn about God from the fact that He wanted to also save Gentiles?

What examples of God's mercy and deliverance can I praise Him for?

**2** **I am called and chosen by God** — *Revelation 17:14 These shall make war with the Lamb, and the Lamb shall overcome them: for he is Lord of lords, and King of kings: and they that are with him [are] called, and chosen, and faithful.*

What am I caused to realize from the fact that God called and chose me?

Why does the devil want me to think that I am an after thought to God?

**3** **I am to be like Christ in demonstrating His love toward others** — *Ephesians 5:1 Be ye therefore followers of God, as dear children; 2 And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us, and hath given himself for us an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweetsmelling savour.*

In what ways did Christ demonstrate His love toward me?

In what ways does my life exhibit Christ's love toward others?

Spirit of Glory, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
