## TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

**KEY IDEAS:** Do I recognize that as a believer I have been set apart from my sins through the blood of Christ? Do I consider myself to be consecrated unto the Lord? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one who is holy and pure? Does my life demonstrate with increasing measure that I belong to the Lord?

**1** **God is set apart from sin and consecrated to do what is good** — *Habakkuk 2:20 But the LORD is in his holy temple: let all the earth keep silence before him.*

How is God better able to meet my needs since He is set apart from evil?

What good things can God do since He is consecrated to doing good?

**2** **I am seen through Christ's death as set apart from sins and consecrated unto the Lord** — *Hebrews 10:10 By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once [for all].*

Why is it best that God sees me as set apart from sin through Christ's death?

Why does the devil want me to think that I am still in bondage to sin?

**3** **I am now to be set apart from sin and consecrated unto the Lord in my walk** — *Leviticus 11:45 For I am the LORD that bringeth you up out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: ye shall therefore be holy, for I am holy. (Compare 1 Peter 1:15f.)*

In what ways is my life set apart from sin? In what ways am I drawn to sin?

In what ways does my life demonstrate that I am consecrated unto the Lord?

Spirit of Truth, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
