TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

KEY IDEAS: Do I recognize that since God created men, then we are accountable to Him for our actions? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one who has already been given the gift of immortality? Shouldn't the fact that I was created and made spiritually alive have impact upon how I live? Do I live only for the present or for the future?

1 **God is the Creator of all life** — *Acts 14:15 And saying, Sirs, why do ye these things? We also are men of like passions with you, and preach unto you that ye should turn from these vanities unto the living God, which made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and all things that are therein....*

What does this verse imply about man's accountability to God?

What examples of God's creation can I praise Him for?

2 **I am a partaker of immortality** — *2 Timothy 1:10 But is now made manifest by the appearing of our Saviour Jesus Christ, who hath abolished death, and hath brought life and immortality to light through the gospel....*

How should I live since I've been made immortal through Jesus' death?

How does it make me feel to realize that I've already been made immortal?

3 **I am to seize the opportunity for eternal reward by doing good works** — *1 Timothy 6:19 Laying up in store for themselves a good foundation against the time to come, that they may lay hold on eternal life.*

What kinds of things are apart of my life for which I will be rewarded?

What role does telling others about Christ's sacrifice play as a good work?

Holy Spirit, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
