TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

KEY IDEAS: Do I recognize that God's power and glory are immense and that no problem is too great for Him? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one who He has destined to be a partaker of Christ's glory? Does my life draw attention to God in all that I do? How do people have a better understanding of God because of my life?

1 **God is surrounded by glory** — *Habakkuk 3:3 God came from Teman, and the Holy One from mount Paran. Selah. His glory covered the heavens, and the earth was full of his praise. 4 And his brightness was as the light; he had horns coming out of his hand: and there was the hiding of his power.*

How is God able to address my needs since His power and glory are so great?

What examples of God's glory and power can I praise Him for?

2 **I am to consider any indignity an honor since it is participation in Christ's suffering and glory** — *1 Peter 4:13 But rejoice, inasmuch as ye are partakers of Christ's sufferings; that, when his glory shall be revealed, ye may be glad also with exceeding joy.*

How do I respond to those who mock or slander me for my faith or service?

What good can come from suffering for Christ?

3 **I am to be a person who seeks to glorify (draw attention to) God in all things** — *1 Corinthians 10:31 Whether therefore ye eat, or drink, or whatsoever ye do, do all to the glory of God.*

How does my life confuse people's perception of the Lord's character?

How does my life demonstrate the Lord's character to others?

Spirit of Truth, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
