## TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

**KEY IDEAS:** Do I understand that since God rules over my life my actions need to demonstrate a reverence for Him? Do I see myself as God sees me, one that He has made to live forever? Does my reverence for God continue to grow? Or, is my reverence for God and the things of God degrading?

**1** **God is to be revered and held in awe** — *Matthew 10:28 And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.*

Why should I hold God in reverence and awe?

For what demonstration of God's mercy can I praise Him?

**2** **I am promised that I shall never die** — *John 11:25 Jesus said unto her, I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: 26 And whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die. Believest thou this?*

What hope and confidence do I gain from the fact that I will live forever?

Why does the devil want me to obsess about here and now and not eternity?

**3** **I am to pursue a respect for God and the things of God** — *Psalms 33:8 Let all the earth fear the LORD: let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of him.*

How does my life demonstrate a respect for God and for the things of God?

What needs to take place in my life to demonstrate a greater respect for God?

Holy Spirit, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
