TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

KEY IDEAS: Do I understand that God has always planned to give all mankind opportunity to experience His mercy? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one He has given the high privilege of declaring salvation to all men? Am I seeking actively to bring others to Christ?

1 **God has planned to draw all peoples and nations unto Himself — Psalm 117:1**
O praise the LORD, all ye nations: praise him, all ye people. 2 For his merciful kindness is great toward us: and the truth of the LORD endureth for ever. Praise ye the LORD.

What reason could all men from every nation have for praising the Lord?

How can I praise God for His grace and mercy to both Jews and Gentiles?

2 **I am a witness to Christ's death and resurrection as a part of His plan — Acts 1:8**
But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

How does my life serve as a witness to Christ's death and resurrection?

Why does the devil want me to leave witnessing to pastors and evangelists?

3 **I am to draw others to the way of righteousness and truth — Proverbs 11:30**
The fruit of the righteous [is] a tree of life; and he that winneth souls [is] wise.

To whom have I told the gospel message? Who have I led to Christ?

For whom do I need to be praying? To whom do I need to witness?

Spirit of Truth, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
