## TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

**KEY IDEAS:** Do I believe that God is not bound by any limits and does He wants to do? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one that has been truly set free from the practice and penalty of sin? Do I understand that I am now free to do things have real meaning and purpose? Do I recognize that I can leave a legacy that will last for eternity?

**1** **God is bound by nothing and does all things according to His own will —** *Ephesians 1:9 Having made known unto us the mystery of his will, according to his good pleasure which he hath purposed in himself....*

What comfort do I find in the fact that He isn't limited or bound by anything?

Which of God's purposes and plans for me give me greatest cause for praise?

**2** **I am free —** *Galatians 5:1 Stand fast therefore in the liberty wherewith Christ hath made us free, and be not entangled again with the yoke of bondage.*

What do I have since I am now free from sin's practice and penalty?

Why does Satan want me to come back under bondage through sin?

**3** **I am free to do good works and be fruitful —** *Titus 3:14 And let ours also learn to maintain good works for necessary uses, that they be not unfruitful.*

Before I was saved, what kept me from doing anything of lasting value?

What incentive do I now have to do things that benefit others and last?

Spirit of Glory, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
