## TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

**KEY IDEAS:** Do I recognize that God's promise to save me is certain? Since receiving Christ am I living with confidence and hope? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one that He has guaranteed to save? Do I behave like one that has a certain hope and future by my witness? Am I telling others about Jesus Christ?

**1** **God is the Author of a message that cannot be broken** — *Isaiah 45:22 Look unto me, and be ye saved, all the ends of the earth: for I am God, and there is none else. 23 I have sworn by myself, the word is gone out of my mouth in righteousness, and shall not return, That unto me every knee shall bow, every tongue shall swear.*

How should I live since God's promise of salvation is certain?

Since He has promised me eternal life what can I praise God for?

**2** **I am guaranteed eternal life** — *Titus 1:2 In hope of eternal life, which God, that cannot lie, promised before the world began.*

Why is it surprising that there are things that God cannot do?

Why does the devil want me to think that my eternal destiny is uncertain?

**3** **I am to be a witness (tell others about the message of eternal life)** — *1 Peter 3:15 But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts: and [be] ready always to [give] an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you with meekness and fear....*

How should I be motivated since the message of eternal life is certain?

What active steps am I taking to tell others about the gift of eternal life?

Spirit of Wisdom, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
