TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

KEY IDEAS: Do I live in such a way that my life demonstrates that I believe that the Lord is watching over me? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one that He loves and He watches out for? In order to increase my effectiveness in prayer am I careful to obey the Lord?

1 **God watches over His servants** — *1 Samuel 26:9 And David said to Abishai, Destroy him not: for who can stretch forth his hand against the LORD'S anointed, and be guiltless?*

Men tend to watch out for the powerful, but for whom does God watch out?

What examples of God's watch care can I praise Him for?

2 **I am promised that God watches out for me** — *Psalm 11:7 For the righteous LORD loveth righteousness; his countenance doth behold the upright.*

How does a person who is right with God behave?

Why does the devil want me to think that God is unaware of me?

3 **I am to seek to be obedient since God watches over me** — *John 9:31 Now we know that God heareth not sinners: but if any man be a worshipper of God, and doeth his will, him he heareth. (Compare 1 John 3:22)*

In what areas of my life has obedience replaced disobedience?

How effective will my prayers be if I ignore God's will?

Spirit of Glory, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
