TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

KEY IDEAS: Do I recognize that God credited Jesus' righteousness to me so in now clothed in Jesus' righteousness? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one that is completely right with Him? Am I running from temptation? Am I taking advantage of the opportunity to obtain protection by doing good?

1 **God is the source of righteousness** — *Romans 3:22 Even the righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference.*

What does it make me realize since God credited Jesus' righteousness to me?

For which of God's steps--that made my salvation possible--can I praise Him?

2 **I am in right standing before God** — *Romans 5:19 For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of one shall many be made righteous.*

Why was it necessary to be made righteous from the actions of one person?

Why does Satan want me to think my good deeds play a part in saving me?

3 **I am to shun evil and do what is right** — *Psalms 84:11 For the LORD God [is] a sun and shield: the LORD will give grace and glory: no good [thing] will he withhold from them that walk uprightly.*

What steps do I take to remove myself from the opportunity to sin?

What steps do I take to put myself in a position to do good and right things?
