TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

KEY IDEAS: Do I recognize that God is a champion and advocate for the helpless? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one that He will protect from accusation in heaven? How must I live in order to be above the condemnation of other men and by my own conscience?

1 **God dwells in holiness** — *Psalm 68:5 A father of the fatherless, and a judge of the widows, is God in his holy habitation.*

In what ways do I need to become like my heavenly Father?

How should I praise my heavenly Father since He is my sinless example?

2 **I am holy, unblameable and without any accusation in God's sight** — *Colossians 1:22 In the body of his flesh through death, to present you holy and unblameable and unproveable in his sight....*

How does it make me feel to know that I will be presented unblameable?

Why does Satan want me to think that I am unworthy to be a Christian?

3 **I am to be pure and holy in my walk** — *Isaiah 1:16 Wash you, make you clean; put away the evil of your doings from before mine eyes; cease to do evil.... (Compare: James 4:8)*

Since following Christ, what evil activities have been eliminated from my life?

What evil activities need to be set aside and removed from my life?

Spirit of Truth, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
