## TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

**KEY IDEAS:** If God showed mercy and love to those who deserved His judgment, what can I expect Him now to do for me, His child? Do I see myself as God sees me, as the Father's precious child and treasure? Do I respond to the Lord with loving obedience?

**1** **God is a gentle and merciful Father** — *Malachi 3:17 And they shall be mine, saith the LORD of hosts, in that day when I make up my jewels; and I will spare them, as a man spareth his own son that serveth him.*

What do I learn about God since He will show mercy and remove an offense?

How should I praise God for removing all the offenses I've perpetrated?

**2** **I am God's child and He is my Father** — *2 Corinthians 6:17 Wherefore come out from among them, and be ye separate, saith the Lord, and touch not the unclean [thing]; and I will receive you, 18 And will be a Father unto you, and ye shall be my sons and daughters, saith the Lord Almighty.*

How do I know I am the Lord's precious child?

Why does Satan want me to resist seeing myself as God's child?

**3** **I am to respond to His commands with loving obedience as God's child** — *John 14:21 He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him.*

Which of God's commandments am I careful to observe?

Which of God's commandments do I need to lay hold of and fulfill?

Spirit of Truth, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
