TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

KEY IDEAS: Do I realize that God is the ultimate source for wisdom and understanding? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one to whom God desires to give wisdom and understanding? Where do I need wisdom and understanding? Am I seeking for God to increase my discernment and comprehension?

1 **God is beyond our comprehension** — *Isaiah 40:28 Hast thou not known? hast thou not heard, that the everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth, fainteth not, neither is weary? there is no searching of his understanding.*

Why is it comforting to know that God is tireless and His intellect is boundless?

How should I praise God since He is tireless and without any limit?

2 **I am granted understanding according to the plan of God** — *Romans 15:21 But as it is written, To whom he was not spoken of, they shall see: and they that have not heard shall understand.*

What do I learn from the fact that God granted understanding to outsiders?

Why does Satan want me to think that God can't increase my understanding?

3 **I am to seek wisdom and discernment** — *Proverbs 3:13 Happy [is] the man [that] findeth wisdom, and the man [that] getteth understanding.*

Do I realize that God is able to give me wisdom and expand my understanding?

Where do I need to have God give me wisdom and understanding?

Spirit of Glory, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
