TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

KEY IDEAS: Do I understand that if it were possible for me to appear before God with faults then God would have failed? Do I see myself as God sees me, faultless and free of any blame through the blood of Christ? What actions do I need to take in order to bring my behaviour in line with God's perception of me?

1 **God cannot do wrong and is without fault** — *Zephaniah 3:5 The just LORD is in the midst thereof; he will not do iniquity: every morning doth he bring his judgment to light, he faileth not; but the unjust knoweth no shame.*

Of what faults do men accuse God of having?

How can I praise God for His sinlessness and for the comfort He gives me?

2 **I am faultless in the sight of God** — *Jude 1:24 Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present [you] faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy*

What hope does it give me to know that God plans to present me faultless?

Why does the devil want me to doubt God's promise that I will be faultless?

3 **Like the saints in the future I am to be faultless in my behavior before men in the present** — *Revelation 14:5 And in their mouth was found no guile: for they are without fault before the throne of God.*

Why is it important for me to act in manner that is faultless before men?

In what areas of my life am I acting in a hypocritical manner?

Spirit of Truth, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
