## TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

**KEY IDEAS:** Do I recognize that since God is holy; He can have nothing to do with sin? Do I see myself as God sees me, as one that is holy through the blood of Christ? Do I understand that to be holy also means consecrated to serve the Lord?

**1** **God is holy** — *Leviticus 20:7 Sanctify yourselves therefore, and be ye holy: for I am the LORD your God. 8 And ye shall keep my statutes, and do them: I am the LORD which sanctify you.*

What difference does it make that God is holy and is set apart from sin?

How can I praise God for His purity and for the comfort His purity gives me?

**2** **I am called by God unto a holy calling** — *1 Peter 1:15 But as he which hath called you is holy, so be ye holy in all manner of conversation....*

How will I live if I see myself as set apart from evil and dedicated to God?

Why does Satan want me to feel like I am expected to do things that I can't?

**3** **As mature saints are expected to pursue a holy lifestyle, I am also to pursue a holy lifestyle** — *Titus 2:3 The aged women likewise, that they be in behaviour as becometh holiness, not false accusers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things....*

Am I pursuing a holy lifestyle? In what areas do I let down?

In which areas do I indulge myself and could disappoint others?

Spirit of Wisdom, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
