## TODAY'S BIBLE STUDY & MEDITATION

**KEY IDEAS:** Do I understand that God has a tender spot in His heart for all of His spiritual children--like me? Do I see myself as God sees me, as the object of His desire and plans? Do I seek to demonstrate that I am a child of God?

**1** **God protects His children** — *Psalm 91:4 He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth shall be thy shield and buckler.*

What evidence is there that I believe that God watches over and protects me?

How can I praise God since I know I have a special place in His heart?

**2** **I am set apart from sin in God's sight and am preserved by Him** — *Jude 1:1 Jude, the servant of Jesus Christ, and brother of James, to them that are sanctified by God the Father, and preserved in Jesus Christ, [and] called . . . . (Compare 1 Corinthians 1:2)*

How is it to my benefit that the Lord keeps me saved?

What does the devil gain if I think my salvation is based upon my performance?

**3** **I am to demonstrate my relationship to God by my pursuit of righteousness** — *1 John 2:29 If ye know that he is righteous, ye know that every one that doeth righteousness is born of him.*

How does my life demonstrate to others the fact that I am born again?

What practical task can I undertake to demonstrate Christ to others?

Spirit of Glory, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?
