1	<p>God and His way are perfect (complete) -- 2 Samuel 22:31 As for God, his way is perfect; the word of the LORD is tried: he is a buckler to all them that trust in him.</p> <p>Since God's ways cannot be improved, how can I benefit from them the most?</p> <p>What illustrations of God's ways being best can I thank Him for?</p> <p>I am identified with Christ and God sees me as already complete (perfect) in Him -- Colossians 2:10 And ye are complete in him, which is the head of all principality and power.</p> <p>Since God sees me through Christ, what exalted position does that give me?</p> <p>Why does Satan want me to believe he is over me?</p> <p>I am to seek to be complete as God is complete -- Matthew 5:48 Be ye therefore perfect, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect.</p> <p>What are my strengths in following the Lord's ways?</p> <p>Where is there need for improvement in following the Lord's ways?</p> <p>Spirit of Truth, how do you want to apply these verses in my life today?</p>

1	God is merciful and protects the righteous with His strength -- Psalm 57:1 <i>Be merciful unto me, O God, be merciful unto me: for my soul trusteth in thee: yea, in the shadow of thy wings will I make my refuge, until these calamities be overpast.</i>
	What in this verse indicates that God's servants will experience calamity?
	What examples of God's deliverance can I thank and praise Him for?
2	I am the object of God's power -- Ephesians 3:20 <i>Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us.</i>
	When have I seen a God's power demonstrated?
	What advantage is it to the devil if I have a low opinion of God's capabilities?
3	I am to depend less upon myself and more upon God and His power -- 2 Corinthians 12:9 <i>And he said unto me, My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness. Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me.</i>
	When have I depended upon my abilities and resources to fix my problems?
	What areas do I need to turn over to the Lord? Where do I need His help?
